Stroh motioned to appoint Angela Stein to fill vacant board position, starting at the regular April meeting. Crimmins seconded. Motion carried 4-0. 4. Stroh motioned to accept the March superintendent evaluation. Boehm seconded. Motion carried 4-0. 5. Crimmins motioned to discontinue the cash payout option for staff health insurance effective at the end of the 2022 fiscal year. Boehm seconded. Motion carried 4-0. 6. Stroh motioned to approve the 2022-2023 school calendar. Boehm seconded. Motion carried 4-0. 7. Bus route transportation was discussed. Offering a route for Goodrich resident students was discussed. 8. Stroh motioned to accept the joint election agreement with Sheridan County. Boehm seconded. Motion carried 4-0. 9. Discussion on gas prices and costs of transportation were discussed. 10. Stroh motioned to adjourn the meeting. Crimmins seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
