

**STUDENT COUNSELING & GUIDANCE  
RECORDS & CONFIDENTIALITY**

School counselors are legally immune from disclosing any privileged or confidential communication obtained during a counseling interview, with the following exceptions: reporting information related to child abuse, when a student requests that confidential information be released, and/or waives his/her confidentiality privilege verbally or in writing.

Counselors shall not abridge confidentiality under any other circumstance unless there is clear evidence of a potential threat to the safety of the student and/or the District.
