

**STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS**

Written reports on student progress will be issued to parents at least twice a year in all grades, K-12, and parents will receive written notice of the availability of report cards at least annually. Quarterly reporting dates will be determined annually and placed on the school calendar.

The McClusky Public School shall hold parent/teacher conferences. The principal is responsible for setting up the conferences. Conferences shall be under the direction and supervision of the principals and conference dates shall be placed on the school calendar.

Teachers may arrange additional conferences with parents in instances when children are having learning or behavioral problems, and parents are encouraged to initiate conferences at any time. Deficiency notices will be mailed to the parents of those children doing failing or unsatisfactory work.
